School Improvements

Following the installation of new windows, external doors and window blinds last summer, the Board of Management replaced all the old furniture in the school. All pupil chairs were replaced and new desks and shelving were installed throughout the school. The old Computer Room was also divided up into four new rooms, which gave us two new Support rooms, a meeting room and an archive room, and these rooms were furnished and resourced. All classrooms received new desktop computers and teachers were given the use of chromebooks to assist with school planning, teaching and learning. School printers and photocopiers were also replaced. We launched a new website and online payment system as well as the Aladdin Connect system for parent/school communication. We have also repaired or replaced all classroom projectors. The external window sills and the presses in the shared areas have been painted and refurbished. The classroom floors are being sealed and polished over the summer and the cleaning staff have given everywhere a deep clean. We are also improving our school yard as a surprise for our pupils when they return to school after sacrificing so much during the pandemic. In addition, the Board has applied to replace the school roof and ceiling and we hope this application will be sanctioned by the Department in the future.

Curricular Development

Our School Self Evaluation continues to focus on the area of SPHE and Stay Safe. Feedback from the pupils shows that more of our students now know the Stay Safe rules. We will also focus on the area of Wellbeing for our school community. The 6th classes led us in a very successful Safer Internet Day this year, culminating in an exhibition in the hall and Amber awards for our pupil ambassadors. All teaching staff attended an inservice day in Drumcondra Education Centre, during the school year, on the new Primary Language Curriculum.
