Brothers Gearoid O Brian & Diarmuid O Brian, Shane Culleton, Tom Nolan and Derek McMullan have rowed from The Canary Islands to Antigua in 33 days, 12 hours and 38 minutes. They rowed 4,800km altogether. Their families traveled to Antigua for a very emotionally family reunion.
