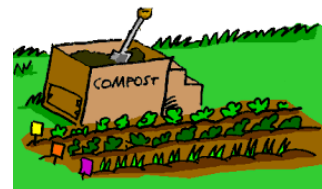
Spring Sponsored Walk in aid of our Courtyards
