Holy Thursday

1. Read about the Last Supper which we celebrate on Holy Thursday.

The Last Supper (Lk 22:13-20) The apostles Peter and John went off and found everything just as Jesus had told them, and they prepared the Passover meal. When the hour came, Jesus took his place at the table with the apostles. He said to them, 'I have wanted so much to eat this Passover meal with you before I suffer! ...' Then Jesus took a cup, gave thanks to God, and said, 'Take this and share it among yourselves ...'Then Jesus took a piece of bread, gave thanks to God, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in memory of me.' In the same way, he gave them the cup after the supper, saying, 'This cup is God's new covenant sealed with my blood, which is poured out for you.'
