On very wet mornings children may use the small pedestrian gate opposite the main entrance and shelter under the canopy at the front of the school. We will open the doors for pupils to come inside as soon as we have supervision for them. As the Winter sets in, please make sure children bring warm, waterproof coats to school each day and appropriate footwear for the weather.
