A big Thank You to PABS who have volunteered to help out at **BaySciFest!** There will be prizes on the day for the best presented Science Questions.

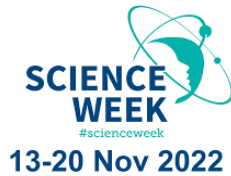
Throughout Science Week there will be a variety of **STEM TALKS** delivered by parents to our pupils. Thank you to all the parents that have devoted their time to the school.
